Dear Friends of Student Ministry,

Since 2015 affiliated Chi Alpha workers have increase by 97%, that is almost doubling the number of affiliated workers! Campus Crusade for Christ (renamed "Cru") and InterVarsity have also seen an increase in campus laborers. This is a great indication that God is moving.

He is preparing us for a harvest. I hope you are ready.

An "event" that I want to remind you of is the 10.2 call to prayer. On October 2nd (10.2) Chi Alpha is inviting everyone to pause, at 10:02 AM to pray for students. No, there is nothing special or "magical" about the numbers. We are calling people to pray at the same time, for the same purpose. This "device" gives us that perfect opportunity.
