
Our goal is to expand the number of students learning and engaging safely on campus. Our **current phase** has 175 students in highly controlled learning environments on the Christiana, Willow Grove, and Glenside campuses in the Forensic Science, Physician Assistant, and Physical Therapy graduate programs, with 40 students living on the Glenside campus. We also are housing 23 students overseas at Arcadia's London Center.



I want to briefly explain the variety of course formats that you will encounter this semester. Each format will run slightly differently; your faculty members are the experts in the class and will change small parts of it as they see fit. But in general, here is the breakdown of the types of courses you will take. The University is using the term Hyflex—as in a highly flexible format—as the larger category that all of these different teaching styles fall into...Remote, Hyflex, Hybrid, Face to Face, Blended...

Hyflex: Classes combine in-person work and synchronous remote learning. What this means to you is on certain days, you go to a classroom. Other days, you attend class remotely, participating through Teams or another video chat. The remote versions of your class occur in real time, which means you will "attend" class virtually at the same time you would be there physically. For example, you might be in class every Monday at 9:40 and log into class every Wednesday at 9:40.



If cases spike, we will take all of the necessary steps to protect the health and well-being of our campus community, which may include some level of virtual learning. We are prepared to adjust our plans as quickly and seamlessly as possible for short or extended periods of time. Here, again, we will be guided by federal and state health officials.
