Dear Friends of Missions,

Thank you for your interest in praying for college students, staff and faculty in Southern New England. The Corona Virus has affected this demographic in unique ways. The dream of a four-year college education, along with an on-campus experience has changed. This past Fall most schools eliminated in class instruction. Students studied from home. The future for these young adults is uncertain. It is basically impossible to make plans. For a generation that thrives on in-person contact and fellowship; social distancing and mask wearing has really put a cramp into their social lives.

The Spring 2021 Semester has been slightly better, but still way different than normal. We are hoping that as students and young adults in general, feel the cramp of Covid-19, that they will reach out to God. 
- Fully in-person classes
