Dear Friends,

This is now the third volume of the New York Ministry Network collegiate prayer guides. We hope to produce a guide for each school in NY. Thank You for your participation in prayer.

Jesus asked us to pray for laborers: Luke 10.2 "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore, plead with the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest" (NASB). We, at Chi Alpha, are asking you to "plead" with the Lord of the harvest. We believe that God wants to send an awakening to America, and that it will start on the college campus! We need your help.

In this guide, like the last, we have tried to find all the Christian organizations on each campus. It is likely that we missed a few. For example, we only know of those churches which are reaching out to campuses if they are listed on the college's website. So, if you are reaching out to students, and you are not listed in this prayer guide, please forgive us. Let us know, and if there are future prayer guides will include you.

Pray for the student leaders of the Christian groups. They are the "soldiers on the front lines". Some of them may not even know that they are in a spiritual warfare. Pray that the Holy Spirit wakes them to that fact. Some of the schools hide the student leader's names. We acknowledged that with a question marked.

You will notice that several schools have chaplains and ministry staff. We never know where they stand on Christ, Sin, Biblical Authority, etc. Pray that God works in them and through them nevertheless.

We also found the names of some of the student group advisors. These are faculty or staff who are Christians and act as an advisor to the student leaders. They too are soldiers on the front line. An added bonus that comes with recognizing an advisor is that they are more "stable". Normally student leaders are voted on every year, whereas the advisor, like the chaplains and ministry leaders on campus, stay in their position for years at a time.

On another note, this prayer guide was compiled with data from the list found at "The National Center for Education Statistics" (NCES) and from each school's own website. For the international student statistics, we used a website called "College Factual". The international statistics are under the "Student Life" tab.

Thank You again for investing time into this next generation. Only eternity will tell what we helped along and what we were able to hinder.

- 2) Pray that this summer God calls people specifically to this school, students, staff and faculty.
- 3) Pray for the student groups. Pray that their summer preparation will go smoothly and that they will be positioned, this fall, to see a harvest.
- 4) Pray for a revival among the Christian students. Pray that the revival will spread to an awakening for the whole campus.
- 5) Pray for the international students, that they will come to know the Lord. Some will return home to countries without an adequate gospel witness.
