Some schools do not show student leader’s names. When that was the case, we have looked for the group’s faculty advisor. That name appears and is so marked. Often, we could not find a contact person at all. When that happened, we inserted a question mark.

Many schools have chaplains or spiritual life offices. Please pray for these men and women, that they too will be sensitive to the leading of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is not bound by denominations or back grounds.

Sadly, you will notice that many schools have no known gospel witness at all. We are believing God to raise up workers for these schools, Luke 10.2.

There is a section on each page for “generic” recommended prayer ideas. Please see this as springboard for prayer. Allow the Holy Spirit to lead you beyond what has been suggested.

We have included a section on international students. We are using the [College Factual](#) website for all pertinent data. At this website the international student information is under the “Student Life” tab of each school.

Finally, we wanted to let you know that this prayer guide was compiled with data from each school’s individual website, as well as the National Center for Education Statistics ([NCES](#)). We only included schools which offer at least an associate’s degree and have a student population of over 350.

Thank you once again, in advance, for investing time into this next generation. Only eternity will tell what we helped along and what we were able to hinder with our prayers.
